Weather Situation - Northern Western Australia

A broad trough lies through the Kimberley, Pilbara and over northern parts of the Gascoyne.

Weather Situation - Southern and Central Western Australia

A trough lies near the west coast with a ridge of high pressure south of the state. Little change is expected in the weather pattern for the next few days with the low pressure trough persisting near the west coast, before moving eastwards later Wednesday and Thursday.

Forecast for the rest of Sunday 21 January

Showers and thunderstorms over the Kimberley, Pilbara, inland Gascoyne, Goldfields, southwest Interior, Eucla and over central and eastern parts of the South West Land Division. Areas of drizzle near the south coast between Hopetoun and Israelite Bay.

Forecast for Monday 22 January

Showers and thunderstorms over the Kimberley, Pilbara, Gascoyne, inland Central West, Central Wheat Belt, eastern Great Southern, Southeast Coastal District, Goldfields, southwest Interior and Eucla. Areas of drizzle over the South East Coastal, Great Southern and western South Coastal districts.

Forecast for Tuesday 23 January

Showers and thunderstorms over the Kimberley, Pilbara, Gascoyne, the Goldfields, west and south Interior, Eucla, central and eastern parts of the South West Land Division. Areas of drizzle over the South and South East Coastal districts.

Forecast for Wednesday 24 January

Showers and thunderstorms over the Kimberley, Pilbara, eastern Gascoyne, central and eastern parts of the South West Land Division, the Goldfields, Interior and the Eucla. Areas of drizzle over near coastal parts between Albany and Israelite Bay.

Forecast for Thursday 25 January

Showers and thunderstorms over the Kimberley, Pilbara, eastern Gascoyne, central and eastern parts of the South West Land Division, the Goldfields, Interior and the Eucla. Areas of drizzle over near coastal parts between Albany and Hopetoun.

The next routine forecast will be issued at 4:45 am WST Monday.
