Western Australia Forecast

Issued at 4:30 pm WST on Wednesday 18 July 2018  
for the period until midnight WST Sunday 22 July 2018.

Weather Situation - Northern Western Australia

A ridge of high pressure extends over central parts of the State and will temporarily drift south during Thursday. On Saturday the ridge will lie over the Pilbara and Kimberley.

Weather Situation - Southern and Central Western Australia

A cold front will brush the south coast and move east during the remainder of Wednesday. A ridge of high pressure will drift south to lie near the south coast on Thursday. A cold front will reach the Southwest Capes late on Friday and then move through the South West Land Division during Saturday. Another cold front will affect the southwest of the State during Sunday.

Forecast for the rest of Wednesday 18 July

Showers southwest of a line Kalbarri to Israelite Bay, with only light falls over inland parts.

Forecast for Thursday 19 July

Showers about the south coast east of Albany, clearing in the evening. Light morning showers near the coast between Perth and Jurien Bay. Showers about the Southwest Capes.

Forecast for Friday 20 July

Showers about the Southwest Capes, tending to rain late in the evening. Showers extending through areas southwest of a line from Jurien Bay to Albany during the afternoon and evening.

Forecast for Saturday 21 July

Showers and rain areas southwest of a line Kalbarri to Ravensthorpe. In the afternoon and evening showers extending to remaining parts of the South West Land Division, and the adjacent Goldfields and the Gascoyne. Moderate falls from rain southwest of a line Jurien Bay to Bremer Bay.

Forecast for Sunday 22 July

Showers southwest of a line Carnarvon to Israelite Bay, reaching to southwest of Exmouth to Eyre later in the day with mainly light falls. Heavier showers and moderate falls southwest of a line Perth to Bremer Bay in the morning and again in the afternoon and evening with the risk of a thunderstorm and small hail.

The next routine forecast will be issued at 4:45 am WST Thursday.
